**MINUTES OF THE 96<sup>th</sup> MEETING OF EMPOWERED COMMITTEE UNDER MULTI-SECTORAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME HELD ON 24.03.2015 UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SECRETARY, MINISTRY OF MINORITY AFFAIRS.**

The 96<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Empowered Committee (EC) for Multi-sectoral Development Programme (MsDP) was held on 24.03.2015, under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Ministry of Minority Affairs, to consider and approve the project proposals with regard to the Minority Concentration Blocks (MCBs)/Minority Concentration Towns (MCTs) received from State Governments of Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Odisha and Manipur. The representatives of the Ministry of Labour & Employment attended the meeting. Director, Minority and Other Backward Classes, Manipur attended the meeting in person and other officials from State Governments of Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, and Odisha attended the meeting through video conferencing. A list of officials present in the meeting in person or through video conference is annexed as annexure - I.

2. **Progress on website:** The progress of implementation of MsDP is reported on quarterly basis to the Delivery Monitoring Unit (DMU) in PMO (Prime Minister's Office) and the status of implementation of various projects in terms of funds released by the Ministry of Minority Affairs and utilized by the State/UT; number of works sanctioned, completed and works in progress is regularly monitored. These details and photographs of works are placed in the Ministry's website for transparency. State Governments/UT Administrations are required to review the implementation on quarterly basis; ensure that Central funds are released to the districts within one month of sanction; State share (wherever applicable) released along with the Central funds; ensure that the executing agencies start the construction works at the earliest, and complete the construction works within the scheduled period. A computer software application called MIS-MsDP has been made operational in July, 2011 and the States/UT have been advised to ensure that data is entered by all concerned so that Quarterly Progress Report (QPR), utilization certificate and various progress reports is generated through the software.

3. **Adhering to guidelines and eliminating duplication:** States/UTs should ensure that the proposals sent have the approval of the State Level Committee of MsDP / mission director of CSS concerned in order to ensure that the proposal, in terms of specification, norms, standards etc., is in accordance with the guidelines of the scheme concerned and that duplication has been ruled out. The

  
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responsibility for eliminating duplication of work and avoiding double counting of a scheme under two funding sources vested with both the district authority and the State Government. Accounts under MsDP should be maintained separately and Central Ministry concerned informed of assets created in respect of CSS topped up under MsDP.

4. The States/UTs were advised by the Empowered Committee to ensure that the catchment area of the assets created under MsDP have substantial minority population. Further the States/UTs would also ensure that the ownership of the asset created would be with the Govt/Govt body.

5. **Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) guidelines:** MsDP provides that there would be no change in guidelines of any existing Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) under implementation in such districts for which this programme would provide additional funds. In case schemes for individual benefits are taken up under the programme, there shall be no divergence from existing norms for selection of beneficiaries from the list of BPL families in the district, so that benefits from the additional funds flow to all BPL families and not selectively. However, the provision under Indira Awas Yojana (IAY) guidelines for making separate allocation for Scheduled Castes (SC) or Scheduled Tribes (ST) will not be followed under MsDP. The entire number of units sanctioned under MsDP would be given to BPL households, from minority communities as well as other communities, in order of the serial number in the approved wait list without making separate allocation for Scheduled Castes (SC) or Scheduled Tribes (ST).

5.1. **Anganwadi Centre:** Wherever Anganwadi Centre has been approved, it should be ensured to follow the norms of Ministry of Women and Child Development that the minimum area of AWC would be 600 sq. feet with a sitting room for children/women, separate kitchen, store for storing food items, child friendly toilets and space for children to play, with drinking water facility.

6. **Timely release of funds:** The sanction letters of the Ministry stipulate that funds should be released to the district/implementing agency within a month's time, but the States/UT have been generally taking much time in releasing funds to the district/implementing agency. State shares, wherever applicable, are not released along with the Central funds by some States. Prompt release of funds was advised to ensure that works are started at the earliest.

7. **Utilisation Certificate:** For release of second installment, utilization certificate (UC) is required. If the UC is furnished within a period of one year after release by the Ministry, 60% UC would be required for releasing the next installment. However, if utilization is made beyond the period of a year, 100% utilization would be necessary. The UCs would need to be accompanied by

  
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QPR showing physical progress as proof of the work in progress. The Utilization Certificates of the 2<sup>nd</sup> and subsequent installment should also be submitted by the States/UTs to the Ministry.

8. **Sample testing and quality control:** Quality control was to be ensured through regular and frequent field visits and by testing samples of the construction work for which funds would be sanctioned by the Ministry on receipt of request from the State concerned. All the States/UTs were advised to carry out field visits, quality control tests and review all works under MsDP to ensure that the shortcomings do not take place in their State/UT.

9. **Inclusion of Members of Parliament in State and district level committees:** Members of Parliament (MP) and Member of Legislative Assembly (MLAs) have been included in the State and district level committees for implementation of the Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities which also serves as the committee for MsDP. MLAs are also to be nominated on the Committees by the State Government. It should be ensured that they are invited to attend the meetings of the district and State level committees.

10. **Display boards:** Para 16.1(ii) of the scheme of MsDP provides for a 'display board' which should have- Name of the project/scheme printed followed by "Multi-sectoral Development Programme (MsDP), Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India." For projects with longer construction period, in addition to above, the name of implementing agency, date of sanction of the project, likely date of completion and estimated cost of the project should be printed on the display boards. States/UT should ensure this and put up a permanent display on completion of each project.

11. **General conditions applicable to projects approved by the Empowered Committee**

For approvals given by the Empowered Committee, including in-principle approvals, the Principal Secretary/Secretary of State's/UTs and the District Collectors/representatives were advised to note that the following conditions would apply to all projects under MsDP. State Government/UT administration concerned should ensure that the following have been complied with:-

**Approval of the State department concerned/Mission Director** for Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) concerned have covered the following -

- (a) **Need** for having the proposal sanctioned under MsDP.
- (b) **Duplication has been eliminated.**
- (c) Proposal is as **per norms, specifications, layout design, funding norms and cost norms of the CSS guidelines** concerned.
- (d) **Separate accounts for schemes under MsDP will be maintained** and details sent to the Central Ministry concerned for maintaining proper record of assets and avoiding double counting and duplication.
- (e) **Estimates have been prepared as per Schedule of Rates (SOR)** of the State Government and have been **approved by a competent engineering department** of the State Govt.

  
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- (f) **Staff is available** for functioning unit or will be provided for new unit.  
(g) **Recurring expenditure** would be provided by the State Government.  
(h) **Land is available and/or will be made available by the State Government in villages/locations having the highest proportion (percentage) of minority population.**

12. **Review meetings of Oversight committee in State, and State and district level**

**committees:** The scheme of MsDP envisages quarterly review meetings by the State and district level committees for implementation of the Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities which also serves as the review committees for MsDP. The State level committee also acts as the Oversight Committee for MsDP. Quarterly review meetings for State level committee/State Oversight Committee and district level Committee should be held and copy of the meeting notice should be sent to the Ministry to enable a representative to attend State Level meetings as envisaged under MsDP. It should be ensured that Members of Parliament nominated in such Committees are invited to attend the meetings.

13. **Photographs:** Photographs of completed works and works in progress indicating type of asset, name of location/village and date should be placed in the MIS-MsDP web page and officials from the State and districts were impressed upon the need to have photographs, in digital format sent by email to **Shri U.K. Sinha, Under Secretary in the Ministry- [ujjwal.sinha@nic.in](mailto:ujjwal.sinha@nic.in)** .

14. The Chairman (EC) emphasized that the benefits accrued by the implementation of MsDP should go to the Minority Communities properly. Therefore, not only location of the assets in the areas having substantial minority population is important, but it is also equally important to see that the assets created are actually imparting benefits to the minorities. The State Governments were impressed upon to propose the locations of projects under MsDP accordingly.

15. All the states under consideration of the EC submitted following declaration with regard to the projects as per Appendix-II of the guidelines:-

- The land for all construction activities is available.
- It has been ensured that all locations proposed have atleast 25% minority population in its catchment area.
- The Cost estimates proposed for different works/projects are as per the standardized cost derived on the basis of norms/ design prescribed by the concerned Ministry for that particular work.
- It has been ensured that there is no duplication of the work with any Scheme of the Center /State Government and concerned Director/Mission Director has been consulted in this regard.
- The maintenance and recurring cost related with the projects will be borne by the concerned department of State Govt.
- The plan proposals has been approved by State level Committee (SLC) for 15 PP Programme.

  
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**(A). Rajasthan**

The EC considered the project proposals submitted by the State Government of Rajasthan in respect of **Alwar, Bharatpur, Barmer, Jaisalmer and Tonk** districts identified for implementation of MsDP during 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan under restructured MsDP. The State Government has furnished declaration in Appendix-II of guidelines of Restructured MsDP.

**Construction of Girls & Boys Hostel in Unanai College at Tonk:-** The State Govt. inform the EC that details sought by this Ministry for this project is being obtained and will be submitted to Ministry shortly. The EC examined the proposal and observed that the construction cost of the hostels are at higher side and requested to the State Govt. for submission of cost abstract and building plan. The EC expressed its in-principle approval for the project subject to justified cost and other terms.

**Construction of Building of Govt. College at Kaman Block in Bharatpur district: -** It was informed by the State Govt. officials that the project is under review and information sought by MoMA will be sent by them shortly. The EC on the request of the State Govt. in-principle agreed for the project proposal subject to justified cost and other terms.

The EC decided to approve the following project, subject to the terms and conditions mentioned hereinabove, and also decided to release the 1st installment of maximum upto 50% of the Central share for implementation of the project so approved:

**(B). Odisha**

The EC considered the project proposals submitted by the State Govt. of Odisha has for construction of two ITIs in Kandhamal district and one ITI in Sundargarh district alongwith required checklist The State Government has submitted all the declaration as per Appendix-II of the Guideline of MsDP.

During the 95<sup>th</sup> meeting of Empowered Committee, the State Govt was requested to identify project location for the proposed ITIs at Kandhamal and Sundargarh districts and submit it with detailed land particulars. The EC also suggested for inclusion of two more trades preferably, Computer Operator and Programming Assistant (CoPA) and Information Technology & Electronic System Maintenance (IT&ESM), in the list of trades. The State Govt has submitted the detail of land and also included one new trade. The EC approved Rs 500 lakh as cost for ITI and beyond this amount the expenditure would be borne by the State.

The EC decided to approve the following project, subject to the terms and conditions mentioned hereinabove, and also decided to release the 1st installment of maximum upto 50% of the Central share for implementation of the project so approved:

### (C). Manipur

The EC considered the project proposals submitted by the State Government of Manipur in respect of Imphal East II-CD Block in Imphal East District, identified for implementation of MsDP during 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan under restructured MsDP. The State Government has submitted all the declaration as per Appendix-II of the Guideline of MsDP.

**Construction of Girls Hostel at the cost of Rs 158.22 lakh :** The State Govt has submitted this proposal at the cost of Rs 202.44 lakh . In the 93<sup>rd</sup> EC, the cost was ascertained for similar projects at Moirangpural High School, Imphal East. Since it has been conveyed that instant project is of the same design and cost as that of the previous one approved by the 93<sup>rd</sup> EC, the cost has been considered at Rs 158.22 lakh.

**Construction of school building at the cost of Rs 74.89 lakh :** The State Govt has submitted this proposal at the cost of Rs 233.135 lakh. In the 93<sup>rd</sup> EC, the cost was ascertained for for similar projects at Moirangpural High School, Imphal East. Since it has been conveyed that instant project is of the same design and cost as that of the previous one approved by the 93<sup>rd</sup> EC, the cost has been considered at Rs 74.89 lakh.

**Skill Training to Minority Youth:** The State Govt has submitted Skill training proposal for 100 trainees at the total cost of Rs 19.00 lakh. The proposal has been discussed and observed that, the skill training would be done for one trade i.e. Garment Construction Techniques, for a period of 4 months (410 hours). Training Fee would be Rs 19,000. The State Govt stated that preference will be given to the poor families, women and disable persons. The EC emphasized that the selection of trainees should be done with transparent manner. It has also been stated by State Govt that successful trainees

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would be given placement through Kongpal leithong Lairembi Weavers Co-Operative Society Ltd. But they have not given 75% placement guaranty.. The State Govt has also requested an amount of Rs 6695 for purchasing of Sewing machines which will be distributed to the successful trainees after competition of the training programme for their placement with the KLLWC or self Employment for their income generation and Rs 24.30 lakh for purchasing of furniture. The EC did not agree to these costs. The EC agreed to this project subject to the condition that a detail break-up of Rs 19,000 will be submitted to our Ministry along with 75% employment guaranty.

EC decided to approve the following projects, subject to the usual terms and conditions, and also decided to release the 1<sup>st</sup> installment upto 50% of the Central share for implementation of the projects so approved:-

**(D). Bihar**

The Empowered Committee observed that a number of big projects like construction of ITI, construction of high school building, construction of hostels etc have been proposed but there was no detailing of estimated cost. Therefore while agreeing for some projects the EC directed the State Govt. to submit the abstract of cost of the projects costing Rs 50.00 lakh or more. The State Govt. was also requested to furnish a certificate of the Ministry of Labour in the State that proposed ITIs are as per NCVT norms and these were required before giving formal approval of the projects.



Accordingly the State Govt. submitted abstract of cost of the projects. EC did not agree to some of the components of the abstract of cost given below:

**Construction of 50 bedded hostel** compound wall, internal road & path and internal water supply and landscaping, contingency and centage charges. The unit cost for the asset was arrived at Rs. 197.00 lakh

**Construction of high school building** Contingency charges and Agency charges. The unit cost for the asset was arrived at Rs. 131.50 lakh.

**Proposal for Milk Production at Katihar:** The EC considered the project proposal and requested the State Govt. to submit a detailed project report to this Ministry. The State Govt. assured the submission of the DPR shortly.

On the basis of the information, the proposal of Govt. of Bihar was placed below in the EC meeting. The State Govt. could not start a number of projects approved during 11<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan mainly related to construction of anganwadi centers due to some reason. One of them is non-availability of suitable land. The State Govt. submitted the alternative proposals for the amount available due to the dropping of the projects.

**(1) Katihar District:** A number of projects sanctioned during 11<sup>th</sup> Five year plan in the district under MsDP were dropped by the State Govt. The total cost of dropped projects is Rs. 3582.168 lakh and the funds released for these projects is Rs. 1908.703 lakh. Out of these amounts, the Ministry has approved projects of Rs. 1514.20 lakh and the adjusted released is Rs. 757.10 lakh. Thus Rs. 1151.603 lakh released to the district is to be adjusted.

State Principal Secretary informed EC in respect of ITI, Barsoi that they would furnish a certificate about construction of ITI at Barsoi as per NCVT norms from the Directorate of Employment & Training at the earliest. The EC decided to approve the following projects, subject to the terms and conditions mentioned hereinabove, and also decided to adjust 1<sup>st</sup> installment so approved:

**(E). Uttar Pradesh**

Govt. of Uttar Pradesh has submitted a project proposal for Innovative Technology Solution for improved Learning Outcomes and Education Quality in government Schools under MsDP. The project is to be implemented by Electronics Corporation India Limited (ECIL) in 447 Govt. Schools. The proposal has been approved by SLC. The State Govt. has also intimated no objection of the State Education Department in this regards. The objective of the project would be following:-

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- a) Introduction of IT Enabled Learning Environment for students
  - b) Capacity Building of Teachers on IT Skills & usage of Multimedia Content.
  - c) Education through Multimedia lessons in Schools through IT Infrastructure.
  - d) Building requisite Infrastructure for providing IT skills & Multimedia lessons to the Students.
2. The components of the project for a school would be following:-
- a) **Computer Lab:** ECIL shall set up a Computer Lab in each schools by deploying 4 Computers on the shared technology mode with adequate Furniture, Electrification and networking
  - b) **Integrated Community Computer:** One Unit of Integrated Community Computer shall be installed in each school for group learning. This is an Integrated system which combines the features of Computing and Projection system in a single unit.
  - c) **Learning Aid:** Comprise of interactive learning interventions which illustrate concepts from the curriculum, in English, Maths and Science. Under this 8 classrooms each school shall be covered
  - d) **Multimedia Contents:** Every school shall be provided with state specific multimedia content for subjects Maths, Science and English as per the Curriculum of the Uttar Pradesh State Board. The content shall be loaded on Computer and Integrated Community Computer.
  - e) **English Kit:** One unit of English Kit shall be provided to each school.
  - f) **Training of Teachers:** 5 teachers per schools shall be trained initially for duration of 10 days and subsequently refresher trainings shall be conducted biannually to ensure the sustainability of the project.
  - g) **Project Management and Technical Support:** The project shall be provided technical support for a period of 3 years. Regular support visits shall be conducted by ECIL to ensure the quality of education being delivered in these schools. A dedicated Call Center shall be deployed for daily monitoring and hardware assistance for the project
    - Baseline and Impact assessment
    - Monitor the delivery of education in schools
    - Setting up of Centralized Control room and Onsite support for IT infrastructure and Toll Free Number- 1800 180 8800
    - Deployment of Project management Team for the efficient implementation of the product.

      - Master Trainer

  
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3. The Empowered Committee considered the above proposal of Govt. of Uttar Pradesh and approved the project for implementation in 300 schools of 35 district (details at annexure-II) of Uttar Pradesh @ total cost of Rs.30,77,4000/-(@ Rs.10,25,800/- per school). 4. It being an innovative project, the funds sharing ratio between Centre and State would be in ratio of 60:40 and central share of funds would be released in three installments of 30%, 30% and 40%. Accordingly, the Empowered Committee approved for release of 1st installment upto 30% of the Central Share to Govt. of Uttar Pradesh for the implementation as a pilot project in 300 Govt. Schools in 35 districts. The subsequent installments for the project would be released only on assessment of project by independent agency appointed by the Ministry. 
