Subject: Grant in aid under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Multi sectoral Development Programme for minority concentration districts (MCDs) to Government of **Uttar Pradesh for the year 2011-12 for Moradabad District.**

Sir,

In continuation to this Ministry's sanction letter of even number dated 01.07.09, 19.03.10, 16.12.10, 3.12.10, 31.12.10, 31.03.11 and 23.12.11, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President for release of an amount of **Rs. 90,00,000/- (Rupees ninety lakh only)** as 1st instalment (50% of total central share) of the total sanctioned amount of Rs. 1,80,00,000/- (**Rupees one crore eighty lakh only**) for the year 2011-12 to the Govt. of Uttar Pradesh for implementing the scheme "Multi Sectoral Development Programme for minorities" for Moradabad district as per the details enclosed at Annexure I. The non-recurring grant may be released to the Govt. of Uttar Pradesh through CAS, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur.

2. The expenditure is debit to Demand No.67, Ministry of Minority Affairs Major Head- "3601" Grant-in-aid to State Government, 04- Grants for Centrally sponsored Plan Schemes (Sub Major Head), 378 -General-(Welfare of Schedule Casts/Schedule Tribes and Other Backward Classes) -Other Grants, 04 - Multi sectoral Development Programme for minorities, 04.00.35 - Grant for creation of capital assets for the year 2011-12.

3. Since it is a fresh release no UC is pending. Utilization Certificate for this grant should be submitted by the grantee in the prescribed format within 12 months of the closure of financial year. As per the conditions contained in para 15.4 of the guideline of Multi sectoral Development Programme, (i) Quarterly Progress Report, (ii) Photographs of the works completed from earlier releases and (iii) work plan for the requisitioned amount with milestones and time frame may also be furnished.

4. The State Government should ensure that a board containing information of the date of sanction of the project, likely date of completion, estimated cost of the project, source of funding i.e. MsDP (Government of India), contractor(s) name and the physical target is displayed. After completion of projects, a permanent display would be installed.

5 The provision of essential tools/equipments/machinery/furniture for Bilari ITI was approved as per advice given by the M/o Labour & Employment that availability of space and power supply must be ensured as per NCVT norms, MES course may be conducted based on above machines, separate equipment may not be required. However, it must be ensured that trade given are not covered in other scheme, availability of Instructor and their salary structure to be provided (if on contract).” The equipments so purchased must be as per the specification prescribed in Standard tool list. State Govt. should ensure these conditions are met before starting the work. The amount would be scrupulously deducted if any deviation, is found at any stage of the implementation of scheme.

6. Within in the one month of the receipt of the release of the amount conveyed through this sanction order, State Govt. will fulfill the commitment required for the projects mentioned at annex-I and convey acceptance to all the terms and conditions, failing which the Ministry will review the project. The conditions conveyed vide this Ministry's letter of even no. dated 23.12.10 may also be referred to.

7. Funds should be released by the State Govt. to the implementing agencies only after all the conditions stipulated while approving the projects are fulfilled. Ministry of Finance; parking of funds at any level is strictly prohibited.

8. Utilisation of the above mentioned amount by the State Government is subject to the terms and conditioned at annexure-II.

9. This sanction issues with concurrence of IFD vide their Dy. 709/IFD dated 24.01.12. It is noted at S. No 160 in the Grant-in-aid Register.
