Additional classrooms:

The State Government should ensure that the cost for the construction of Additional classrooms was approved by the State PWD and the State Government was asked to provide a list of villages where these centres would be constructed.

Construction of Anganwadi Centres

The State Government should ensure that the centres were located in villages/mouzas which have the highest concentration of minority population in all the 7 CD blocks in the district. Toilet and water facility may be provided in these anganwadi centres from the Total Sanitation Campaign (TSC) programme and Accelerated Rural Water Supply Programme (ARWSP) respectively in case it was not covered within the unit cost of Rs 3.00 lakh. The State Government assured to provide a list of villages where these centres would be constructed.

The State Government would ensure that the IAY guidelines for selection of beneficiaries would be followed and BPL families selected from the approved waiting list, even if they belong to communities other than the minority communities, strictly in order of their ranking in the list. State share would be provided. The list of the villages where these houses would be constructed would be furnished by the State Government.
