Drinking water facility

- (a) The approval was given on the condition that the approved cost was as per ARWSP norms.
- (b) Villages having the highest proportion of minority population would be selected.

Indira Awas Yojana (IAY)

- (a) The IAY houses would be distributed among the BPL families from the approved waiting list, even if they belonged to communities other than the minority communities, strictly in order of their ranking in the list as per the IAY guidelines.
- (b) Villages having the highest proportion of minority population would be selected.
- (c) State share would be provided.
- (d) List of the villages would be furnished.
