





- (a) **Construction of additional class rooms (ACRs) in high schools:**
- (i) The State Government would ensure that the cost for the construction of ACRs was approved by the PWD, provide land and State share, and a list of villages where the schools were situated along with the proportion of minority population.
 - (ii) To prevent duplication, the Government of Bihar may ensure that the ACRs funded under MsDP were reflected in the State Action Plan of the scheme and information also sent to the Ministry concerned.
- (b) **Construction of school building for primary and middle schools:**
- (i) The State Government would ensure that the cost for the construction of ACRs was approved by the PWD, provide land and State share, and also a list of villages where these schools would be constructed.
 - (ii) To prevent duplication, the Government of Bihar may ensure that the schools funded under MsDP were reflected in the State Action Plan of the scheme and information also sent to the Ministry concerned.
- (c) **Construction of anganwadi centres:**
- (i) The villages having the highest proportion of minority population in all the blocks would be selected and the list would be provided.
